# Bash - Parameters

- The first parameter passed to the script is \$1, the second \$2 and so on
- If you want to check more than one possibilities of parameter passed to the script then a case is useful

```
case "$1" in
start)
    # start
    Anweisung 1
    Anweisung 2
    Anweisung 3
    ;;
stop)
    # stop
    Anweisung 1
    Anweisung 2
    Anweisung 3
    ;;
*)
    # anything other
    echo "Use: {start|stop}" >&2
    exit 1
    ;;
esac
```
